

VIRGINIA HORSE INDUSTRY BOARD PRESENTS THE "VIRGINIA BRED" GRANT PROGRAM

The Virginia Horse Industry Board has established a "Virginia Bred" Grant Program to promote the breeding of quality horses in the state of Virginia. The ASHAV Futurities have received grant money from this program to be added to our payouts for those who meet the "Virginia Bred" criteria.

Program Requirements:

- 1) The colt or filly must be Virginia Bred. Under the "Virginia Bred" grant program the horse must have been foaled in Virginia. Location of the stallion and mare at time of conception does not alter this requirement. Please return the completed foal certificate (below) to the ASHAV futurity.
- 2) Also the proposed recipient must be "actively engaged" in the breeding of horses in Virginia. To qualify the person must satisfy at least one of the following criteria.
 - a) The person (regardless of legal residence) must have stood a stallion for one complete breeding season in Virginia during the previous three years.
 - b) The person (regardless of legal residence) must have owned a mare or mares which were either bred in Virginia or stabled in Virginia for one year during the previous three years.
 - c) If a Virginia resident, the person must demonstrate activity in the Virginia horse breeding activity.
